May 2016 RPOT Report

- 1. The Diocesan Advisory Committee (DAC) visited The Parish Of Three Saints (TPOTS) on 18th April to see our church buildings and our plans for changing them to meet modern requirements. The DAC was led by the Archdeacon Nicola Sullivan with an expert team of 12 DAC members. The size of visit indicates the interest by DAC in our significant project and the session proved most helpful and informative.
- 2. On 20th April a presentation was given to Brent Knoll Parish Council with an audience of local Brent Knoll inhabitants. Question time was particularly active and some interesting points were raised. A final rendering of this presentation will be given to Lympsham Parish Council on 16th May.
- 3. The first meeting of the RPOT Working Group took place at The Clocktower, Rossholme, East Brent. It was well attended by representatives from the three Parish Councils, schools, Methodists and TPOTS PCC. Following personal introductions, the Terms of Reference for the WG were agreed and progress-to-date detailed and discussed. Next WG meeting will be on 18th May when a Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats (SWOT) exercise will be started.
